



A solid lawn of weed grass seedlings, you *do not want to see any more* growing in California in December to February, that can kill native seedlings. Each foot tall they grow is one ton of fire-fuel--even if mowed, can still burn homes to the ground.



Thick stands of native broadleaf seedlings, like Miner's Lettuce—As they grow will give off chemicals that kill the weeds, and produce zero fire fuel for summer.
